Knowsley Valves and civils project deemed a success

Scott Robinson, Operations Engineer for PMC Knowsley provides an update on some of their recent works.

PMC Knowsley have been undertaking a number of P11 and P20 inspections as part of the valve and civils project for JN Bentley on behalf of GTO Delivery Services. The purpose of the project is to re-life a number of AGI's.

This has involved inspecting a number of corrosion features on valve vent and sealant lines and classifying the damage. The wider project involves site grit blasting and coating, and also valve investigation works where valves are not sealing.

This project has been a massive help in up-skilling technicians into P11/20 inspections and helped expose Knowsley to more gas transmission works. Not only has this up-skilled technicians, but also myself whilst carrying out the Mechanical Damage Assessor's role. This project has also assisted with securing works directly for West Area Operations.

It has been good to work alongside JN Bentley and also to carry out inspections in the West area".
